Dear Mr. Cifor:

This letter acknowledges receipt of your permit application dated August 6, 2024 to construct and operate a municipal solid waste landfill at the eastern side of Cumberland County, north of Route 60, bounded by Route 654 (Pinegrove Road) and Route 685 (Miller Lane). The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Piedmont Regional Office staff has completed its initial review of your application. Based on that review, the proposed request has been determined to be subject to the permitting requirements of Chapter 80, Article 6 of the Virginia Regulations for the Control and Abatement of Air Pollution. Please note, however, that this determination is subject to change upon further review.

Based upon this initial review, the application does not contain sufficient information to begin the application review process. Additional information will be needed before processing may begin and before the application may be considered complete:

- Form 7, page 10: Please ensure that the Document Certification Form is dated and signed by the Responsible Official.
- An Air Pollution Activity Siting and Value Form signed by the authorized local official, certifying that the proposed facility or activity is suitable to the area in which it is located and provides the value of the proposed facility or activity pursuant to Chapter 13 (§10.1-1307E) of Title 10.1 of the Code of Virginia (see the Suitability and Value Form). This form or an alternative letter or email containing the information requested herein must be submitted to DEQ before a permit can be issued.

- An updated application that incorporates the recent changes to AP-42, Chapter 2.4: Municipal Solid Waste Landfills, and that utilizes the most recent version of LandGEM to estimate emissions from the proposed municipal solid waste landfill.
- The excel spreadsheets used to develop the calculations presented in this application.
- The conditional use permit referenced under section 3.1 (page 3) of this application.

It is important that you provide the required information above so that the engineering staff can complete the review of your application in a timely manner.

If a later analysis of the permit application indicates that additional information is required to support your application, such information will be requested at that time.

You are reminded that construction of a municipal solid waste landfill subject to the permitting requirements in Chapter 80 of the Virginia Regulations for the Control and Abatement of Air Pollution, without the appropriate new source review permit, can result in enforcement action.
