Wolf Creek TMDL – Initial Public Meeting

Landon discusses the sediment impairment revision of the Wolf Creek TMDL. Wolf Creek has a benthic impairment due to high levels of sediment. The watershed size is approximately 17,000 acres. Landon discusses the 6 Clean Water Quality Standards, specifically going in detail about the importance of aquatic life. He explains the importance of benthic sampling and how this type of work helps DEQ determine stream health.

Landon then goes into the discussion of how a TMDL is developed and what modeling strategies are used to determine the stressors in the water.

Attendees from the Town of Abingdon mention the idea of doing some urban practices within the town, if applicable to the Implementation Plan when developed.
