The incident describes "heavy stream sedimentation" and "work on the MVP causing heavy red mud to be released to the creek".</li> <li>Observations: <ol> <li>MVP is completing install of full length permanent waterbars from 13889+00 to 13892+00 and was stabilizing slope with matting and removing the RCE at the time of inspection.</li> <li>MVP is starting bank repair to S-II2 at STA 13915+00 and has opened a travel lane from Iron Ridge Road to S-II2 (STA 13892+00 to 13915+00). In-stream work had not started at the time of inspection.</li> <li>No impacts were observed to S-II2 or Little Creek from the MVP ROW.</li> <li>Controls were in place and functioning properly at the time of inspection.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Corrective Action: N/A</li> </ul>




Figure 2: **STA 13898+00** – Travel lane installed for access to S-II2 bank repair. Controls in place and functioning properly.
