PURPOSE OF NOTICE: To seek public comment on an Emergency Permit from the Department of Environmental Quality to a facility to manage hazardous waste in Farmville, VA. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: August 13, 2025 to September 12, 2025

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Longwood University applied for an emergency permit on July 31, 2025 and received the emergency permit on August 1, 2025 to treat hazardous waste at the Longwood University Chichester Science Center, 501 High Street, Farmville, VA 23909. In an emergency situation, the DEQ may issue an Emergency Permit to allow a facility to manage hazardous waste in a manner which is protective of human health and the environment. The waste being treated is five glass bottles of 2,4-Dinitrophenol having the waste codes D003 and P048, and two glass bottles of 2,4-Dinitrophenylhydrazine having the waste code D003. The material will be treated by saturating the contents with water to stabilize for shipment to a disposal facility.
